IT Centre to bridge gap between demand & supply of professionals

Students having the basics of JAVA can enroll in it

The Technology Academy for Competency Training (TACT), Vidyanagar, will soon be offering training on Social Mobility Analytics Cloud (SMAC) and other emerging technologies like Big Data, Cloud Computing and Mobility Courses like Android and iOS. Students having the basics of JAVA will be able to enrol in this academy. The institute will now be open for students interested in Information Technology (IT) with an aim to bridge the huge gap between the demand and supply of IT professionals. It is developed by Collabera, an IT staffing firm.

Sunny Shah, director of TACT said, "Through this institute we want to create the talent that is ready for the market." He predicted that there will be a demand of over 75,000 trained IT professionals by the end of 2017 in India. The academy has already been training working professionals but this is for the first time that students will be trained under the academy.
